A great time was had by all at the end of term party in the vicarage garden.

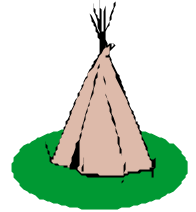

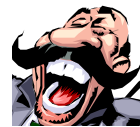


Christmas is Coming
